<p>Be artistic – compile a collage on the subject of natural disasters.</p> 	 <p>Find out about the Thames Flood Barrier and explain why you think it is important.</p>	<p>Wind and water can be used to provide energy. What can you find out about alternative energy?</p> 
<p>Make a model of the human heart.</p> 	 <p>Make and use your own weather station and keep a daily record of the weather.</p>	<p>Produce a fact file about the human circulatory system.</p>

As we did last term, the children will have their 'Homework Challenge book'. We are expecting one double page to be used for each topic or you may choose to make a model, depending on the options available.
