Our topic this term is '**World War I**' - the following are all ideas that tie in with our class work this half term:

<p>Find out where your local War memorial is. Visit and take photos for your topic book.</p> 	 <p>Discover how animals were used during World War I. Present your information in an interesting way.</p>	<p>Produce a piece of art work with poppies as the central theme.</p> 
 <p>In your neatest handwriting produce a decorated copy of the poem "In Flanders Fields".</p>	<p>What is your local infantry regiment? What is their regimental badge? Write a fact file of key facts.</p>	<p>Research the footballer/soldier Walter Tull.</p> 

The challenge work for Autumn 2 is due in on 17/12/18

As we did last term, the children will have their 'Homework Challenge book'. We are expecting **one double page** to be used for each topic or you may choose to make a model, depending on the options available.

It is completely up to the children to decide how they want to record it. They could use photos, diagrams, drawings or something else! If you would like to do more than a double page then this is absolutely fine too. All we ask is that everyone has a go, so they all have something to share at the end of each term.
