During ENGLISH lessons we shall be concentrating on reading comprehension skills. We will be focussing on the following areas of writing:

- Biographies
- Explanations
- Journalistic writing
- Narrative texts



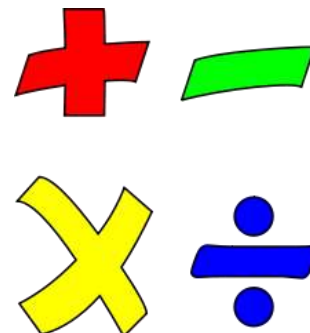
These will be linked to our topic: The Great War and the text we are reading in class –
“Stay where you are then Leave” by John Boyne.



It is still important that your child reads regularly and from a wide range of texts to help develop their knowledge of interesting vocabulary and the features of different text types. We ask that you continue to listen to your child read a minimum of 3 times a week - about 15 mins a time, this may only be a couple of pages but it will help to ensure that they understand what they have read, develop their reading stamina and contribute to their writing. It really helps to develop and enhance the ideas they have for their own writing. Please help your child by filling in their reading record when they have read at home. It can be ANY book, not just their reading book or library book.

In MATHS we will be focusing on:

- Number – four operations
- Number – fractions
- Geometry – position and direction
- Problem solving and reasoning skills
- Multiplication facts
- Arithmetic – calculations and skills
